NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING

The Randolph County Board of Commissioners has called a special meeting for **September 12, 2022** at 6:00 p.m., in the Randolph County Historic Courthouse, 145-C Worth Street, Asheboro, to consider the following:

ALEXANDER JAMES WILLIAMSON, Franklinville, NC, has requested an appeal for the decision made by the Randolph County Planning Board to approve a rezoning for 2.45 acres at 2299 Whites Memorial Rd., Franklinville Township, Tax ID #7784402024, Secondary Growth Area, from LI-CD – Light LI-CD - Light Industrial - Conditional District and RA - Residential Agricultural District to LI-CD - Light Industrial - Conditional District. The proposed Conditional Zoning District would amend the existing site plan to specifically allow for a proposed 60x200 building as per the site plan.

Interested citizens are invited to attend this meeting and will be given the opportunity to express their views. As a result, changes to the request could be made during this public hearing process.

After the Public Hearing, the Board will address the following items:

- Hear an update on the Randolph County Water and Sewer Master Plan draft
- Consider funding repair work at the Seagrove-Ulah Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Go into Closed Session pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11(a)(5) to establish, or instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating the price and other material terms of a contract or proposed contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange, or lease. There may be action after the Closed Session pertaining to the I-74 Industrial Center Project.
